



- monetary policy for the Member States whose currency is the euro
- the conservation of marine biological resources under the common fisheries policy
- common commercial policy


Shared




EU budget and 27 Member States' budgets



Where does the money come from (revenue)?




Where does the money go? Total 2022: €169.5 billion




EU Expenditure 2021-2027 (billion)
